

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

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

It looks like "NEP 2020" refers to the New Education Policy (NEP) introduced by the Government of India in 2020. This policy aims to overhaul India's education system and bring significant changes across all levels of education, from school to higher education. Key highlights include changes in curriculum structure, emphasis on foundational literacy and numeracy, promoting multidisciplinary education, integrating vocational education, and introducing reforms in assessment and governance. The NEP 2020 also emphasizes flexibility and choice in education, aiming to make India a knowledge superpower.

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 is a comprehensive framework introduced by the Government of India to transform the education system in the country. Here are some key aspects of NEP 2020:

- 1. School Education: The policy emphasizes foundational literacy and numeracy in primary education. It introduces a 5+3+3+4 curricular structure, replacing the old 10+2 structure, with early childhood care and education (ECCE) as an integral part.
- 2. **Multilingualism:** NEP 2020 promotes multilingualism and aims for proficiency in regional languages alongside Hindi and English.
- 3. **Higher Education:** The policy aims to increase the Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER) in higher education and focuses on multidisciplinary education, flexibility in curriculum, and credit transfer.
- 4. **Teacher Training:** There is a focus on continuous professional development of teachers and the establishment of a National Mission for Mentoring to provide support to teachers.
- 5. Assessment Reforms: The policy advocates for a shift from rote learning to competency-based learning and assessment.
- 6. **Technology in Education:** NEP 2020 emphasizes the use of technology in education, including online education and digital repositories.
- 7. Equity and Inclusion: There is an emphasis on ensuring equity and inclusion in education, with specific provisions for disadvantaged groups.

Overall, NEP 2020 aims to restructure the education system to make it more inclusive, holistic, and geared towards preparing students for the challenges of the 21st century.




